**Due to Covid-19, the Annual Giving Tree will look a little different this year. The Cathedral of Immaculate Conception will host online giving for the Annual Giving Tree. Here are the many options to give:**

1. Purchase items from one of our two Gift Registries and have your items sent directly to the Cathedral by Dec. 3<sup>rd</sup>. We are registered at Target and Walmart. Here is how to login:

**TARGET:** Go to [target.com](https://www.target.com) > gift registry > enter "First Name" as **Cathedral**, "Last Name" as **Fort Wayne**.

**WALMART:** Google "Walmart Gift Registry" > select "**Event Registry**". Enter "Organization" as **Cathedral**, "State" as **Indiana**, click "Find Registry". When the list comes up, select the line for **Cathedral**, and begin shopping.

Registries will be closed by Dec. 6<sup>th</sup>.

2. Tax-deductible monetary gifts can be made by creating an online giving account on our Cathedral website at <https://www.osvonlinegiving.com/181>. Please select the Christmas Giving Tree option.

3. Checks and cash can also be given in the weekly offertory or sent by mail to the **Cathedral of Immaculate Conception at 1102 S. Clinton Street, Fort Wayne, IN 46802**. Please note in the memo or on the envelope "Giving Tree" contribution.
